PROM does not an estimate of profits as this is their first tennis event. However, our agreement will be the same as PGA in that 8% of the complete event's net profit is placed into a volunteer pool and divide by the total volunteer shifts and will get paid per shift. We would not even know what to guess but, we would suspect the profit would be similar to PGA or PROM would not be doing it. Students, as well as adults, are able to work but our adult/student ratio equal.

Rough schedule: NOTE close is totally depending on matches which could go really long but generally set to be 6 hour shift. If it goes longer we would get 1/2 shift credit.
