I have had a couple people ask about what to do with Scrip if they have already paid their fees for this year. Here are the answers.

2) If you are a senior parent and your student's fees are paid off, you can continue to participate in Scrip and assign those rebates to go towards another student in the band. We have several families that already do that.

3) If you don't know which family to help support, you can always have your rebates put toward general accounts such as "Winterguard" or "Percussion" so that everyone in that specific group can be supported.
